



## ***Student Internship and Field Study Opportunities at GNAT-TV***

Excite and inspire your students by collaborating with GNAT-TV. Students learn media making skills, including technical proficiency, storytelling and collaboration.

### **COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT**

Students connect with their community and produce content that provides information, promotes civic discourse, cultural engagement and a platform for local voices to be heard.

- **Community Storytelling:** Students create original videos highlighting the work, services and offerings of local non-profits and community groups (food pantries, community gardens, pet shelters, etc.), using interviews and storytelling techniques
- **Public Service Announcements:** Students produce PSA's to offer important information to the community
- **"On the Street" Segments:** Students produce interviews portraying what local people think and care about

### **PORTFOLIO Development**

- **Podcasts:** Students create professional podcasts for distribution on GNAT-TV
- **Citizen Journalism / News Production:** Students produce news segments on topics of interest to the community
- **Produce an Original TV Show:** Students produce a TV show from concept to post-production

### **COMMUNITY SERVICE**

Students fulfill hours/credits requirements for Community Service by:

- Filming and editing local community events, sporting events and government meetings
- Assisting with organizational projects at GNAT-TV: digitizing archives, creating/organizing a music library for local producers, organizing equipment inventory, etc.
- Volunteering at live GNAT-TV studio events
